ABOUT THE PROJECT:

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will begin work reconstructing a 3.5-mile segment of State Road (S.R.) 369 (Crawfordville Highway) from South of East Ivan Road to North of S.R. 267 in Wakulla County.

IMPROVEMENTS:

- Widening the existing two-lane roads to four lanes
- Milling and resurfacing
- Drainage improvements
- New signage and pavement markings
- Signalization improvements
- Constructing a new box culvert
- Installing sewer pipe

TRAFFIC IMPACTS:

To help minimize traffic impacts, lane closures are prohibited from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. and on holidays. Access to residences and businesses will be maintained at all times. Please slow down when driving through the construction zone and watch for crew and equipment entering and exiting the roadway.
