

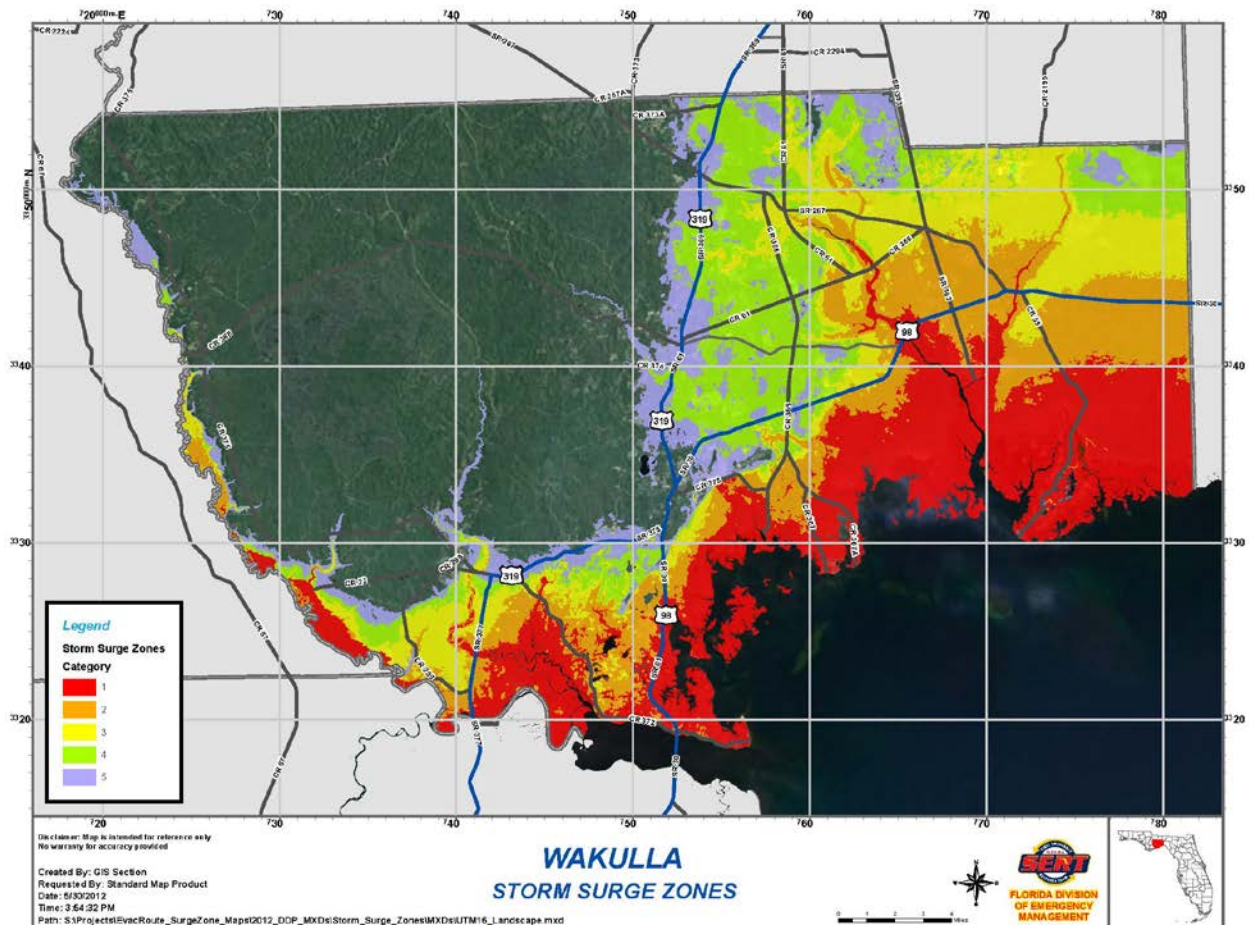
Know Your Flood Hazard

Wakulla County has experienced flooding over the years throughout many areas in the County. One of the biggest flooding threats is from tropical storm surge; however, riverine flooding and flooding in low lying areas can occur with a large rain event too.

If requested, the County will provide information from FIRM panels and historic flood documents to citizens, so that they can better understand flood hazards in their area. Contact the Wakulla County Planning and Community Development Department at (850) 926-3695 for more information.

Storm Surge Zones

One cause of flooding can be from tropical storm systems. Below is the storm surge map to show how far water can reach into the County from hurricanes.
