Recovery by the Numbers: As of Nov. 2

IHP

- **90,288** IHP registrations.
- More than **22,600** applications for over **\$90.6** million approved.
- ONA: **9,631** approved applications. Over **\$15.9** million approved. Average award **\$1654**.
- HA: more than **19,626** approved applications. Over **\$74.69** million approved. Average award: **\$3,805**.
- **15,705** homeowners and renters approved for rental assistance.
- TSA: **1,020** survivor households currently checked into hotels, **354** survivors have checked out.
- Total DRC visits **7,700**. There are **13** DRCs, and **six** MRICs open.
- Housing inspections issued: **58,560**; returned: **55,294**; outstanding: **3,266**.

SBA

- Received more than **7,787** applications and has approved over **\$84.7** million.

NFIP

- Approved over **3,872** claims for over **\$26** Million, **30** percent of claims closed, and.

USACE

USACE has installed more than **2,052** Blue Roofs, and received **32** FEMA Mission Assignments totaling over **\$215 million**.

DSA

- DSA has conducted more than **897** community visits, more than **22,532** home visits, and made more than **11,700** referrals to whole community resources.
- FEMA is working to build community resiliency for the next hurricane by providing risk reduction, mitigation and resiliency information to **1,786** survivors.

SHELTERS

- **Five** shelters are open with a population of **576** survivors.
