

**WAKULLA COUNTY
RESOLUTION # 09-22**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WAKULLA COUNTY, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CITIZENS REVIEW COMMITTEE THAT WOULD REVIEW AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS AS TO BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS REGARDING THE WETLANDS ORDINANCE, SECTION 32 OF THE LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE, AND SETTING FORTH A SUNSET DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Wakulla County values the wetlands contained within its geographical boundaries, and

WHEREAS, protecting the environment while not creating additional costs to the taxpayers is of great importance to the citizens of Wakulla County, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Wakulla County has a need to assure the efficient and fair and continued application of its Wetlands Ordinance, and

WHEREAS, this ordinance applies to the County as well as to private citizens, and

WHEREAS, the review of the Wetlands Ordinance would not concern itself with any ongoing cases;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the elected Board of the County Commission of Wakulla County that 1) A Citizen Advisory Committee will be established within six week's time from the adoption of this resolution, 2) That the Committee will consist of five (5) voting members, with each Commissioner appointing one member to the Committee, 3) That the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners will have his appointed member serve as the chairperson of the advisory committee, 4) That the County Administrator will appoint one non-voting

ex-officio member to the committee from County Staff, 5) That no member of the Code Enforcement Board shall serve as a member of this advisory Board, 6) That the Committee will meet at least twice a month and make monthly progress reports to the Board of County Commissioners, 7) That County staff will be provided to take minutes; 8) That the Committee will meet within the normal business hours of the County and 9) That the Committee will sunset at six months from the date of the establishment of the Advisory Committee.


This resolution shall become effective upon adoption by the Board of County Commissioners.


PASSED AND DULY ADOPTED, in regular session with a quorum present and voting, by the County Commission this sixteenth day of June 2009.
