FDOT to Host State Road 61 (Crawfordville Highway) Public Meeting

Chipley – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host a public information meeting concerning realignment and improvements to the intersection of State Road (S.R.) 61 (Crawfordville Highway) and S.R. 30 (U.S. 98) and continuing to north of Alaska Way. The meeting is Thursday, May 15, from 5 p.m. to 6 p.m. EDT at the Medart Assembly of God Fellowship Hall, 4647 Crawfordville Highway, Crawfordville. The meeting will follow an open house format. Meeting materials will be displayed and attendees will be able to preview maps and documents, ask questions and provide comments concerning the project.

The intent of this project is to realign the intersection of S.R. 61 and S.R. 30, including improvements to both S.R. 30 and old S.R. 61. Americans with Disabilities Act improvements will be included in this project with sidewalks and bicycle lanes being constructed along both sides of S.R. 61. Public participation is solicited without regard to race, color, national origin, age, sex, religion, disability or family status.
