



On June 21, 2010 the Board adopted the Initial Assessment Resolution for Solid Waste Management and Disposal. A Solid Waste Assessment is a charge imposed against residential property to fund solid waste management and disposal services, facilities, and programs. The proposed rate of assessment for the upcoming fiscal year is \$112.00 per dwelling unit.

This assessment will eliminate fees for residential household garbage delivered to the County's landfill. As a resident of Wakulla County, you can take your household garbage to the landfill without paying a tipping fee.

If approved by the Board at the September 9, 2010 Public Hearing, this assessment will be collected on the ad valorem tax bill to be mailed in November 2010. Failure to pay the assessment(s) will cause a tax certificate to be issued against the property which may result in a loss of title.
