

Department Overview

Wakulla County EMS is a County-operated, provider of emergency medical services. The Ambulance Service began operation on September 1972 and celebrated its 35th anniversary in 2007. Wakulla EMS is the sole EMS provider for Wakulla County.

Wakulla County EMS operates 3 advanced life support ambulances 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. In addition there is a Chevrolet Yukon that serves as a supervisory vehicle which contains medical and disaster supplies. Minimum staffing for ambulances is one Paramedic and one Emergency Medical Technician. The Director and Supervisors are also Paramedics. The County EMS Service operates out of three stations located throughout the County.

Wakulla County EMS has 18 full and part time Paramedics and EMT's as well as a flex pool of "on-call" staff of 17. In addition there are 2 Supervisors, 1 Financial Administrative Assistant and 1 Director.
