SR 369/US 319 (CRAWFORDVILLE HWY) MULTI-LANE & MILLING AND RESURFACING PROJECTS

SR 369/US 319 (Crawfordville Hwy) from South of Wakulla-Arran Road to the Leon County Line Financial Project ID (FPID): 419315-1-52-01 (Milling and Resurfacing)

The improvements proposed for this segment include the milling and resurfacing of the existing roadway, the upgrade of existing guardrails, the modification of curb ramps and the construction of minor drainage improvements. This project, which is over eight miles in length, will not require right-of-way acquisition.

SR 369/US 319 (Crawfordville Hwy) From East Ivan Road to the Leon County Line Financial Project ID (FPID): 220495-2-52-01 (Multi-lane Reconstruction Project)

This segment begins at East Ivan Road and ends at the Leon County line, a total of 5.6 miles in length. The project will have a rural typical section consisting of two 12 foot wide travel lanes in each direction, five foot wide outside paved shoulders and a 40 foot wide grassed swale median. Roadside ditches will be used to convey roadway runoff to the 11 storm water management facilities on the project. The right-of-way width varies throughout the project length. The posted speed will be 55 mph through most of the project. Improvements to SR 267 and the intersection of SR 369 and SR 267 are also planned.

SR 369/US 319 (Crawfordville Hwy) from North of Lost Creek Bridge to East Ivan Road Financial Project ID (FPID): 220495-3-52-01 (Multi-lane Reconstruction Project)

The proposed project will utilize an urban typical section consisting of four 12 foot wide travel lanes, four foot bike lanes and a 20 foot wide grass median including curb and gutter, curb inlets and storm drain piping that convey storm water to storm water management facilities along the urban segment. The urban typical section will be utilized from Lost Creek Bridge through the community of Crawfordville to East Ivan Road, approximately 4.7 miles in length. The minimum right-of-way width required for this typical section is 100 feet. Additional right-of-way will be purchased to meet that minimum requirement and accommodate storm water facilities. The posted speed will be 35 mph through downtown and 45 mph in the north and south end of the project.
