

On January 6, 2009 the Wakulla County Board of County Commissioners held a public workshop and approved amendments to Florida Municipal Code Chapter 23 Parks and Recreation Ordinance for Wakulla County.

A portion of the Ordinance specifically amended was section 23.005(a)(19) concerning yard sales, rummage sales on County property which now carries a \$15.00 per day fee:

“Conduct any yard sale, rummage sale, or any other similar sale of new or used personal property unless properly permitted through the Parks and Recreation Department, except for such events organized and sponsored by Wakulla County. County-recognized non profit organizations shall be permitted to conduct fund raisers with the guidelines outlined on the use permit. Violation of the above sub section constitutes a non-criminal offense, punishable by fine of up to \$50.00 and shall be cause for immediate ejection from the park.”
