Announcement of First Responder Graduates – Scott McDermid, Public Safety Director
The First Responder Program has provided care to the citizens and visitors of Wakulla County for decades. When the program began, it was the only First Responder Program in the State of

Florida, and many report it was the first in the nation. The First Responder Program was developed to include the citizens in our County's emergency response system and reduce the time from a 911 call to the arrival of help. The following students have successfully completed the 60-hour course: Mark Webb, Donna Longfellow, Clay Kuersteiner, Adam Hindle, Charlie Ingle, Steve Fults, Deborah Fults, Melissa Paul, and Candace O'Conner.

Scott Nelson, Emergency Management Director provided the Board with a update regarding the Deepwater Horizons Oil Spill. Mr. Nelson summarized actions that have been taken to date and oil sightings. Mr. Nelson announced Workforce Plus is working with the County to provide employment; interested citizens should contact Workforce Plus at 926-0980. Mr. Nelson will continue to focus on this issue and will keep the County updated.
