



Work Authorization

to

Wakulla County Road Paving Preparation Construction Agreement for
Invitation to Bid 2009-021 between

Wakulla County, Florida, a political subdivision of the State of Florida

and

Coastal Construction of Wakulla, Inc.

I. PROJECT

Coastal Construction of Wakulla, Inc. (“Coastal”), shall furnish and pay for all management, supervision, financing, labor, materials, tools, fuel, supplies, utilities, equipment, services, and incidentals necessary to prepare Old Bethel Road from Wakulla Arran Road to Gavin Road for 20 feet of asphalt paving, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents, schedules, and typical drawing sections.

II. SCOPE OF WORK

Coastal shall perform the following:

1. Prepare approximately 2.25 miles of Old Bethel Road from Wakulla Arran Road to Gavin Road for asphalt paving. The cost for this road preparation shall be based on the Unit Prices as submitted in attachment 3 (Price Bid Page) of the Road Paving Preparation Invitation to Bid No. 2009-021, and as stated in the Construction Agreement for ITB 2009-021 entered into by and between Wakulla County and Coastal. Road base material will be provided and trucked by Wakulla County or its approved contractors. Road Base shall be limerock and shall be 6 inches minimum compacted thickness. Swales **must** be provided along all sections of this road. Stormwater will not be allowed to “spill off” into adjacent properties.
2. Prior to the paving of any road project, Coastal shall be responsible for any repairs to any work performed by the bidder, including but not limited to repairs to damage caused by weather or due to vandalism or other outside causes. Coastal is responsible for coordinating with C.W. Roberts Contracting for scheduling paving in a timely manner after base preparation. Coastal will be further responsible for coordinating with Wakulla County to schedule testing. Wakulla County must approve the base and sub-base prior to paving. Wakulla County will provide testing services for this project.

3. Coastal will be responsible for maintaining mail service to all residents located along Old Bethel Road. All mailboxes shall be moved up to the proposed edge of pavement as directed by Wakulla County. The mailboxes must be moved after the compacting of base material. Extremely heavy or illegal or block mailboxes will be removed by Wakulla County.
4. All intersections must be prepared for a minimum asphalt radius of **fifty** feet.
5. All construction shall conform to the Wakulla County Standards for Road and Bridge Construction, as well as the latest Florida Department of Transportation Construction Standards, including the Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, and the latest edition of the Manual of Uniform Minimum Standards for Design, Construction, and Maintenance for Streets and Highways.
6. Maintenance of traffic shall be the responsibility of Coastal. Vehicular access shall be maintained at all times on this project. Coastal shall post a notice a minimum of seven days prior to construction notifying the public and residents along Old Bethel Road that construction will be commencing and the date of such construction. Said sign shall be a minimum 2' x 3' in size and shall be white with black letters, with the format approved by Wakulla County prior to installation. Said sign shall be posted at all access points to the road under construction, with a minimum of one sign and a maximum of four.
