

BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
WORKSHOP: To Allow the City of Tallahassee to Present
Modifications on the T. P. Smith Advanced Wastewater
Treatment Facility
THURSDAY, MARCH 11, 2010

The Board of County Commissioners in and for Wakulla County met for a Workshop on Thursday, March 11, 2010 with Chairman Howard Kessler presiding. Present were Commissioners Mike Stewart, Lynn Artz, Alan Brock (absent), and George Green. Also, present were County Administrator Ben Pingree, County Attorney Heather Encinosa and Deputy Clerk Evelyn Evans.

During the February 16, 2010 Board Meeting, the City of Tallahassee updated the Board through a PowerPoint presentation regarding the T. P. Smith Advanced Wastewater Treatment Project. The presentation included the status of the project and proposed modifications. At the conclusion of the presentation, the Board invited the City to come back for a Workshop.

At this Workshop the City of Tallahassee provided the Board with a recap of the modifications through a Power Point presentation. At the conclusion of the presentation, the Board and citizens were provided an opportunity to discuss and ask questions in order to further educate themselves on proposals/applications being presented on the T.
