WORKSHOP: To Discuss Nitrogen-Reducing
Onsite Wastewater Treatment Systems
THURSDAY, MARCH 25, 2010***

The Board of County Commissioners in and for Wakulla County met for a Workshop on Thursday, March 25, 2010 with Chairman Howard Kessler presiding. The researchers have been collecting data to evaluate the effectiveness of both conventional septic systems and Performance Based Treatment Systems in removing total nitrogen from wastewater.

The workshop served as an educational and informative meeting that provided the Board with an opportunity to better understand the study results on the Performance Based Treatment Systems in the County. The Board was provided an opportunity to ask questions from the presenters of the study teams so that they could better understand the findings as presented.
