

**Board of County Commissioners**  
**Workshop: Proposed Comprehensive Sewer Ordinance**  
**March 16, 2009**

The Board of County Commissioners in and for Wakulla County met for a Workshop on Monday, March 16, 2009 at 5:00 p.m. with Chairman Howard Kessler presiding.
