

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WAKULLA COUNTY, FLORIDA PLACING ON THE BALLOT A QUESTION REGARDING THE CONTINUED LEVY OF 0.25 MILLS FOR CRITICAL OPERATING NEEDS PROPOSED BY THE SCHOOL BOARD OF WAKULLA COUNTY, FLORIDA; PROVIDING CERTAIN OTHER MATTERS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on July 19, 2010, the School Board of Wakulla County, Florida (“School Board”) held a regular meeting at which it adopted a Resolution, a copy of which is attached hereto (the “Resolution”); and

WHEREAS, such Resolution provides for an election to be held on November 2, 2010 to determine the question whether the School Board has the authority, by annual supermajority vote, to continue to levy 0.25 mills for critical operating needs for the 2011-2012 and 2012-2013 fiscal years pursuant to s.1011.71(3)(b), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, s.1011.71(3)(b), Florida Statutes, provides that such millage “must be approved by the voters of the district at the 2010 general election” in order to be continued into the 2011-2012 and 2012-2013 fiscal years; and

WHEREAS, the School Board has requested the Board of County Commissioners of Wakulla County, Florida to place such question on the ballot.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Wakulla County, Florida, as follows:

Section 1. In accordance with the request of the School Board, the question whether the School Board has the authority, by annual supermajority vote, to continue to levy 0.25 mills for critical operating needs for the 2011-2012 and 2012-2013 fiscal years pursuant to

s.1011.71(3)(b), Florida Statutes, in accordance with the Resolution, is hereby placed on the ballot for a referendum election on November 2, 2010.

Section 2. A copy of this Resolution shall be transmitted to the Supervisor of Elections for Wakulla County, Florida.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
