I am very interested in applying for the attorney position to represent the Wakulla County Value Adjustment Board for 2010. I think that I am well qualified for the position as I represented the Wakulla County Property Appraiser from 1975-2004, including before every VAB and during which time the Appraiser was upheld by the VAB in every case.

Then in both 2006 and 2007, I was a Special Magistrate for exemptions and classifications for the Monroe County Value Adjustment Board. All of my recommended orders were upheld by the Monroe County Value Adjustment Board and none were appealed to Circuit Court for review.

Then in 2009, I was a Special Magistrate for exemptions and classifications for the Leon County Value Adjustment Board. All of my recommended orders were upheld by the Leon County Value Adjustment Board and none were appealed to Circuit Court for review.


I have completed the DOR certification process for Special Magistrates in 2010 and I have been tentatively hired by the Leon County Value Adjustment Board to serve as a Special Magistrate. I will check to see if there is any additional training or certification that I need to do to be certified to be the VAB Attorney. If so, it will be done immediately. I will also check to see if I can be both a Leon County Special Magistrate and the Wakulla County VAB Attorney. If I cannot do both, then I will pursue being only the Wakulla County VAB Attorney if the Board is interested in hiring me.

I would propose an hourly rate of \$175, which is below my normal hourly rate, for matters before the VAE. If there is subsequent litigation in the Circuit Court, we would need to negotiate that representation separately at probably \$250 per hour. If the Board wishes to hire me, they need to do it as soon as possible so that I can contact Leon County and resolve that matter accordingly.
