PROCLAMATION

WAKULLA COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS August 10-16, 2008

WHEREAS: Federally Qualified Health Centers are nonprofit, community-owned and operated health providers serving uninsured and medically underserved people in Wakulla County; and

WHEREAS: Federally Qualified Health Centers expand access to affordable, high quality, cost-effective health care to all people and contain health care costs by fostering prevention and integrating the delivery of primary care with aggressive outreach, patient education, translation and other enabling services; and

WHEREAS: Federally Qualified Health Centers have made great strides in the Wakulla County health care system specifically by maintaining high standards of accountability, demonstrating cost effectiveness and efficiency in the delivery of care, and empowering communities to address unmet health needs, reduce health disparities, and reduce preventable deaths, costly disabilities, and communicable diseases; and

WHEREAS: Federally Qualified Health Centers are staffed by doctors, nurses, pharmacists and other health professionals who have chosen to serve in communities in need, helping to expand the reach of primary care and preventive health services; and

WHEREAS: There is a continuing need to support implementation of Federally Qualified Health Centers throughout Wakulla County as part of the Wakulla County's enduring commitment to the provision of quality primary health care; and

WHEREAS: Health Centers promote 100% access and zero health disparities to help achieve health care for all people;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Edward E. Brimmer, Chairman, Board of Wakulla County Commission, do hereby proclaim the Week of August 10 - 16, 2008 as "**National Health Center Week**" in *Wakulla County* and urge citizens to recognize the important contributions of Federally Qualified Health Centers in safeguarding health and improving the quality of life for all people in the Wakulla County.
