Workshop: Commissioner Travel Budgets
February 3, 2009

The Board of County Commissioners in and for Wakulla County, Florida met for a Workshop on Tuesday, February 3, 2009 at 5:00 p.m. with Chairman Howard Kessler presiding. Present were Commissioners George Green, Lynn Artz, Alan Brock and Mike Stewart. Also present were Assistant County Attorney Steve Mitchell, County Administrator Ben Pingree and Deputy Clerks Evelyn Evans and Donna Richardson.

The purpose of this workshop is to review and discuss the Commissioners Travel Budgets.

County Administrator Ben Pingree outlined the current travel budget for the Commissioners. Currently, all travel and related expenditures for each Commissioner is accumulated into one line item under travel.

The Board directed staff to set up five district departments with the fuel and travel being combined. The general consensus of the Board was for flexibility to move monies. This would be if a Commissioner had used all of his funds and needed additional funding for travel he/she could request the funding from a fellow Commissioner. Under this system each Commissioner will be able to track their total expenditures.

This item will come back on a future Agenda for ratification.
