The Chairman is responsible for appointing one member for a (1) year term and one member for a (3) year term plus one alternate. The Vice Chairman is required to do the same. The other three Commissioners pick one member each for a (2) year term.</p> <p><i>Chairman appointed Ron Piasecki for a three year term. One more member for a (1) year term and one alternate is also needed by Chairman .
