

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WAKULLA COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO THE CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD FOR WAKULLA COUNTY; APPOINTING A NEW MEMBER TO THE CODE BOARD; RATIFYING PREVIOUS APPOINTMENTS TO THE CODE BOARD; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 162.05, Florida Statutes, authorizes the Board of County Commissioners of Wakulla County (the "Commission") to appoint a code enforcement board to enforce any County codes or ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has enacted Ordinance No. 2003-06, which provided for the creation of the Wakulla County Code Enforcement Board (the "Code Board"), and defined the Code Board's purpose, powers, duties, and membership; and

WHEREAS, the Commission now desires to ratify the re-appointment of three members to the Code Board and to appoint one new member to fill the unexpired term of a vacant seat on the Code Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Wakulla County, Florida, that:

SECTION 1. RECITALS. The above recitals are true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. RATIFICATION OF APPOINTMENTS TO WAKULLA COUNTY CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD. The Commission hereby ratifies the re-appointment of Jeff Ewaldt, David Edwards and Jimmie Doyle to the Code Board for three (3) year terms ending December 31, 2012, and affirms that such re-appointments were valid ab initio, as of January 1, 2010.

SECTION 3. APPOINTMENT OF CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD MEMBER TO FILL UNEXPIRED TERM. The Board hereby appoints Russell McKeithen to serve as a new member of the Code Board, to fill the unexpired term ending December 31, 2012 of, and the seat vacated by, David Edwards, whose resignation was submitted on May 12, 2010.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall become effective on June 7, 2010.
