

**AMENDED RESOLUTION \_\_\_\_\_**

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE WAKULLA GARDENS SUBDIVISION IN UNINCORPORATED WAKULLA COUNTY TO BE IN URGENT NEED OF ROAD STABILIZATION IMPROVEMENTS IN THE INTEREST OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE OF THE RESIDENTS.**

**WHEREAS**, Tropical Storm Fay in 2008 and other tropical storms and rain events have caused severe flooding in the Wakulla Gardens Subdivision, resulting in the isolation of the neighborhood for extended periods of time; and

**WHEREAS**, Wakulla County desires to undertake the necessary road stabilization activities to mitigate flooding to enable access to county public works, law enforcement, emergency, medical and first responders during disaster and rainfall events.

**WHEREAS**, The Wakulla County Board of Commissioners desires to amend Resolution Number 10-27 as follows.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WAKULLA COUNTY, FLORIDA THAT:**

1. The Wakulla County Commission declares the Wakulla Gardens Subdivision, located in unincorporated Wakulla County, to be in a state of Urgent Need of road stabilization to mitigate severe flooding activities in the interest of the public health, safety and welfare.
2. Wakulla County is unable to fund the needed road stabilization for flood mitigation activities without grant funds.
3. Wakulla County has identified the 2008 Disaster Recovery Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding as the only present resource available to fund the road stabilization to mitigate flooding activities for the Wakulla Gardens Subdivision.
