Subject: Request Board Approval of an Interlocal Agreement with the City of Saint Marks for Provision of Code Enforcement Services

Statement of Issue:

This agenda item requests Board approval of an Interlocal Agreement with the City of Saint Marks for provision of Code Enforcement Services. The Interlocal Agreement sets forth the proposed terms and conditions for the County's provision of Code Enforcement services within the City of Saint Marks (Attachment #1).

Background:

In the past, the County has provided code enforcement services within the City of Saint Marks. Going forward, it is recommended that the County and City clarify and formalize the relationship in the form of an Interlocal Agreement entered into pursuant to section 163.01, Florida Statutes. Pursuant to section 163.01, Florida Statutes, local governments in Florida may enter into an Interlocal Agreement for the performance of functions which the governments could exercise independently.

Analysis:

The attached Interlocal Agreement is intended to grant the County the continued authority to provide code enforcement services within the municipal limits of the City of Saint Marks. The County is currently providing these services within the City and this agreement is not intended to change the terms or the delivery of these services; it is merely intended to clarify the County's responsibilities going forward. The Saint Marks city council has approved this agreement.
