Workshop: Citizen Advisory Groups
March 3, 2009

The Board of County Commissioners in and for Wakulla County, Florida met for a Workshop on Tuesday, March 3, 2009 at 5:00 p.m. with Chairman Howard Kessler presiding. Present were Commissioners George Green, Lynn Artz, Mike Stewart, and Alan Brock. Also present were County Attorney Ron Mowrey, County Administrator Ben Pingree and Deputy Clerk Evelyn Evans.
