A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
WAKULLA COUNTY, FLORIDA, REGARDING HONORING PAUL CLARK
FOR HIS EFFORTS IN SAVING THE STATE AID TO LIBRARIES
PROGRAM FUNDING

Whereas, Wakulla County Public Library is a cornerstone of Wakulla County's educational system, providing programs for children, families, adults, and elders to enrich their understanding of the world; and

Whereas, Paul Clark has been a dedicated employee of Wilderness Coast Public Libraries and a valued resource of Wakulla County Public Library for the past 14 years; and

Whereas, Paul Clark spent the better part of 6 weeks of his own time at the Capitol holding signs and sending the message to Legislators that cutting the State Aid to Libraries program would cripple rural county libraries like Wakulla County Public Library; and

Whereas, in the late hours of April 26, 2010 the Florida Legislature restored funding to the State Aid to Libraries program at the full amount to maintain Florida Library's eligibility for Federal grants; and

Whereas, Paul Clark has been recognized for his efforts on the floor of the Florida Senate, in nationwide media, and by the Florida Libraries Association;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Wakulla County Board of County Commissioners, in regular session and duly assembled, thanks and honors Paul Clark for his undying service to Wakulla County Citizens through his efforts at the Legislature preserving library funding and his hard work with the Wakulla County Public Library.
