Subject: Request Board Approval to Adopt a Resolution for the Appointment of a New Code Enforcement Board Member

Statement of Issue:

This agenda item requests Board approval to adopt a Resolution regarding appointment of a new Code Enforcement Board (“Code Board”) member to fill a vacant seat (Attachment #1).

Background:

The Board of County Commissioners is responsible for the appointment of members and alternates to the Code Enforcement Board in the event of a vacancy pursuant to section 162.05, Florida Statutes and section 2.166, of the Wakulla County Code of Ordinances.

Analysis:

In August 2010, Mr. R.E. Meadows informed the Code Board that he would be resigning from the Code Board and subsequently on August 9, 2010, submitted a letter of resignation. As Mr. R.E. Meadows, a realtor, was appointed by Commissioner Green, Commissioner Green has selected George Johnston to fill the unexpired term of that seat upon approval by the BOCC. In order to continue to strive to meet the composition preferences for the Code Board set forth in the section 2.166, Wakulla County Code of Ordinances (that the Code Board consist, whenever possible, of an architect, a business person, an engineer, a general contractor, a subcontractor, a realtor, and another citizen), preference was given to someone who currently works as a realtor within Wakulla County.

This agenda request is seeking Board approval of the Resolution for the appointment of George Johnston to fill the unexpired term of R.E. Meadows, which expires December 31, 2011. This agenda request has been reviewed by the County Attorney.
