The 4-H Youth agent will assume overall leadership in planning, developing, conducting and evaluating the 4-H youth development program in Wakulla County. The 4-H program includes a broad range of youth development programs such as leadership and citizenship, animal science and environmental education. The agent will also work with adult audiences, training and recruiting volunteer leaders. Guiding volunteers in raising private funds to support 4-H programs is also expected.

This agent is expected to maintain an active and effective advisory committee. 4-H programs are based on local inputs from a 4-H youth advisory committee. Knowledge of community-base programming and non-formal educational principles is necessary.

The successful candidate must have the ability to work effectively with a diverse audience including minorities, community leaders, media outlets and the general public. The agent will assume other responsibilities as assigned by the County Extension Director or Northwest District Extension Director.

Wakulla County is a coastal rural community of 29,542 people in Northwest Florida. Crawfordville is the county seat of Wakulla County, 17 miles south of Tallahassee, the State Capital. Wakulla County has a youth population of 4,372 of 4-H age.

A Masters degree is preferred. A Bachelor's degree in youth development, agricultural education, environmental education, family and consumer sciences, volunteer development, or closely related field is required. Course work in youth development and youth experience is preferred. The successful candidate should have a strong commitment to education. Job requirements include frequent evening and weekend work. Wakulla County residence is strongly encouraged and the agent is expected to be an active member of the local community. The University of Florida will conduct a criminal background check on finalists.
