JOB DESCRIPTION**

EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN I

JOB SUMMARY

Provide pre-hospital care within the scope of Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) training and per Wakulla EMS protocols. Hold and maintain EMT certification as set forth by State of Florida statutes.

KEY AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY:

- A. Maintain professionalism at all times.
- B. Provide medical care to the Basic Life Support level, including but not limited to
 - 1. Airway adjuncts
 - a. Oropharyngeal and nasal airway
 - b. Suctioning
 - c. Use of bag-valve mask
 - d. EOA or equivalent
 - e. Oxygen administration
 - 2. Bandaging and splinting
 - 3. Extrication and use of extrication equipment
 - 4. Patient assessment
 - 5. Other duties as assigned.
- C. Complete daily check-in of vehicle and report needed repairs. Check fluids on a daily basis and prn.
- D. Completion of paperwork in a thorough and timely manner.
- E. Safe and efficient driving.
- F. Perform all physical requirements of the job, including but not limited to standing, lifting, bending, carrying, assembling materials, walking swiftly, climbing stairs and walking through rough terrain.
- G. Subject to mandatory call-ins for man-made or natural disasters.
- H. Attend all mandatory department in-service and skills training.

REQUIRED CERTIFICATIONS AND TRAINING:

- A. Emergency Medical Technician certification by State of Florida
- B. BLS Provider card by agency recognized by State EMS office - American Heart Association preferred
- C. Emergency Vehicle Operator Course
- D. Florida Driving License with E endorsement
- E. Completion of National Incident Management System (NIMS) training within three months of hiring date
