Emergency Medical Technician (Flex/On-Call)

The Wakulla County Board of County Commissioners is seeking qualified applicants for **Flex/On-Call Emergency Medical Technicians** (EMT) within the County Department of Public Safety's Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Division. This position will report directly to the Director of EMS, through assigned shift supervision, to provide direct patient care by providing basic pre-hospital life support, other emergency care, and rescue services as an integral part of an all hazards response agency. Duties include the operation and maintenance of ambulances, medical equipment, and supplies.

Applicants must meet the following qualifications: High school diploma or possession of an acceptable equivalency diploma and certification from the State of Florida in pre-hospital medical care.

LICENSES, CERTIFICATIONS OR REGISTRATIONS: Possession of a valid Florida Driver's License. Must maintain both Florida Emergency Medical Technician certification and maintain a current Basic Life Support Certification, as required in Chapter 401, F.S. Must possess certification of completion of a Florida approved E.V.O.C. course. Must maintain any other courses as required by Wakulla EMS Continuing Education and Quality Assurance programs. Must be approved by the EMS Medical Director to practice as an EMT.
