Wakulla County (Northwest District)

The FCS/EFNEP agent is responsible for planning, implementing and evaluating educational programs for families, with emphasis on nutrition. The FCS/EFNEP agent is responsible for the education and managing any program assistants available for the Expanded Food and Nutrition Educational Program delivering nutrition education to needed groups throughout Wakulla County. The agent must have knowledge of sustainable community-based programming and educational principles. This position will take the lead in the areas of community development, which may include volunteerism within communities and rural/eco tourism. The successful candidate must demonstrate ability to work with community agencies and groups in collaborations and partnerships, establish a strong local advisory committee and develop good media relations. The agent will recruit, train and utilize volunteers in building strong programs, seek grant funds to enhance programmatic efforts and provide support for the county FCS program. The agent must have the ability to work effectively with a diverse audience including minority, community leaders, media, and general public. Multi-county programming with neighboring counties is expected. The agent will assume other responsibilities as assigned by the County Extension Director or Northwest District Extension Director.

Wakulla County is a coastal rural community of 29,542 people in 10,910 households in Northwest Florida. Crawfordville is the county seat of Wakulla County, 17 miles south of Tallahassee, the State Capital.

A Bachelor's degree is required. A Master's degree is preferred with at least one degree in family and consumer sciences. A degree in education or a closely related field will be considered. Course work in family development and nutrition experience is preferred.

The successful candidate should have a strong commitment to education. Job requirements include frequent evening and weekend work. The successful candidate must pass a physical examination and background check as required for Wakulla County. Residency in Wakulla County is strongly suggested upon employment and the agent is expected to be an active member of the community.
