

The Wakulla County Board of County Commissioners in conjunction with the Wakulla County United Firefighters Association is seeking qualified applicants for a full-time fire chief/fire code inspector position. The successful candidate will work under limited supervision directing the activities of six paid firefighters who will provide day shift staffing for three county fire departments. The incumbent will respond to fire and other emergencies and may serve as emergency incident commander. He/she will supervisor paid firefighters conducting non-emergency functions such as, but not limited to, hydrant inspections, development of pre-fire plans and vehicle and equipment maintenance. The incumbent will review building construction plans and conduct on-site inspections to insure compliance with state and county fire code requirements.

The successful candidate must be computer literate, able to work well with the public and able to communicate clearly both verbally and in writing. He/she must possess Firefighter II certification and a state fire code inspector certification. The successful applicant will be allowed up to twelve months from the date of hire to obtain the code inspector certification.
