The Wakulla County Board of County Commissioners is seeking qualified applicants for a full time position in the Planning and Zoning Department. The successful candidate will work under limited supervision performing supervisory and administrative work directing and carrying out county policies and procedures relating to all aspects of Land Use Planning and Development Review. Typical work includes developing and managing the long-range planning program, daily zoning permits and development permit applications, working with and advising the County Administrator and Board of County Commissioners, Planning Commission, and various other County and governmental officials.

The director is responsible for the daily operation of the Planning and Zoning offices and attends County Commission and Planning Commission meetings and supervises the staff necessary for planning related information, the development of needed regulations pertaining to growth management and serves as the Chairperson of the County Technical Review Committee, and enforces compliance with the Comprehensive Plan and Development Code requirements. Candidate must be computer literate and familiar with internet research, work well with the public and communicate clearly verbally and in writing. A Master's degree in urban or regional planning or AICP registry is preferred with at least three years of progressively responsible professional experience. A combination of experience and education may substitute for the educational requirements. Future certification as an AICP may be suitable if completed within two years of the hiring date. Salary will commensurate with experience and education.
