

Seasonal Maintenance Worker  
Parks and Recreation Department

The Wakulla County Board of Commissioners is seeking qualified applicants for part-time Seasonal Maintenance Workers within the Department of Parks and Recreation. This is routine work providing a safe and clean environment for park visitors. Work consists of skilled and unskilled manual tasks and projects. The duties require the ability to do heavy physical labor efficiently and have the ability to use and operate various routine maintenance equipment and tools and have the ability to operate such equipment in a safe manner.

Work is performed under the supervision of the Parks and Recreation staff who lays out the routines and details of specific assignments or projects and constantly monitors the work in progress and upon completion.

Minimum qualifications: Applicants must possess a valid drivers license, be currently enrolled/attending high school, graduation from high school or possession of an acceptable equivalency diploma with one (1) year of semi-skilled maintenance work.

(A comparable amount of training, education or experience can be substituted for the minimum qualifications.)
