The Wakulla County Board of County Commissioners is seeking qualified applicants for a temporary (OPS) full-time SHIP Rehabilitation Specialist/Section 8 Housing Inspector. The successful candidate will work under the supervision of the Housing Director and will be responsible for performing Section 8 inspections and SHIP inspections in accordance with Local, State and Federal guidelines. Must be able to follow directions and respond to complaints.

The successful candidate must be computer literate, able to work well with the public and able to communicate clearly both verbally and in writing. He/she must possess a valid Florida Driver's License and be capable of operating heavy equipment. Candidates should be aware that this position requires the ability to crawl under houses, climb ladders and work outside in the elements. Preference will be given to applicants with knowledge of governmental purchasing procedures.

Starting salary is \$12.26 an hour. This is a temporary position with no benefit package. Funding is through a Federal Grant and is anticipated to last through 2012.
