Abraham won 3rd speeches!

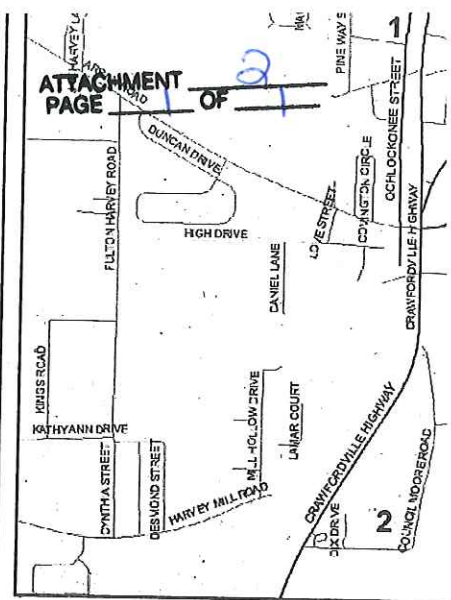
