Subject: Workshop for FDOT to Provide an Update on the Hwy. 319 Corridor Project and to Present the 30% Plans

Statement of Issue:

This workshop is to allow FDOT to provide an update on the Hwy. 319 Corridor Project and to present the 30% Plans.

Background:

On April 5, 2017, staff provided the Board with the following update regarding the Hwy. 319 Corridor Project after meeting with FDOT:

- Engineering is less than 30% at this point for the segments from the Lost Creek Bridge north to East Ivan Road.
- FDOT is planning on improving connecting County roads to accommodate four lanes effects from Hwy. 319 (Feathering).
- The County and Kimley-Horn are seeking grant dollars from the State to perform a cost benefit/feasibility study for a JPA with FDOT on stormwater management.

On May 15, 2017, the BOCC held a Workshop for FDOT to provide an update relating to the Hwy. 319 Corridor Project (Attachment #1). The project schedule is as follows:

- **Engineering Design, Plans, and Permitting**
 - Roadway Survey (Complete)
 - Roadway Environmental Review (Complete)
 - 30% Plans Due June 2017
 - 60% Plans Due February 2018
 - Public Information Meeting Date to be Determined
 - 90% Plans Due April 2018
 - 100% Plans) Due September 2018
- **Right-of-Way Acquisition**
 - Date to Be Determined. Not Currently Funded.
- **Bidding and Construction**
 - Date to Be Determined. Not Currently Funded.

On August 7, 2017 the BOCC approved staff to schedule this Workshop.
